Children

- ♥ 275 children served
[89 Kingsport; 93 Bristol; 93 Hawkins County]
Gender: 49% Female; 51% Male
Ethnicity: 91% Caucasian; 1% African American; 8% Multi-racial
- ♥ 157 new children [43 Kingsport; 62 Bristol; 52 Hawkins County]
- ♥ 197 cases closed [66 Kingsport; 76 Bristol; 55 Hawkins County]
- ♥ Factors experienced by Children served:

Domestic Violence – 32%	Parent Incarcerated – 25%
Drug Exposure/Substance Abuse – 60%	Physical Abuse – 17%
Sexual Abuse – 7%	Poverty – 36%
Mental Health issues of Parent/Caregiver – 60%	

Volunteers

- ♥ 40 Active volunteers [Kingsport – 19; Bristol – 11; Hawkins Co. - 10]
- ♥ 4,137 volunteer hours contributed
- ♥ Average age: 57
- ♥ Gender: 85% Female; 15% Male
- ♥ Ethnicity: 98% Caucasian; 2% Multi-racial
- ♥ Average length of time a volunteer is assigned to case: 16 months

- ♥ Guardianship: 7 / 4%
- ♥ Other: (Kinship/non-relative Placement) 10 / 5%

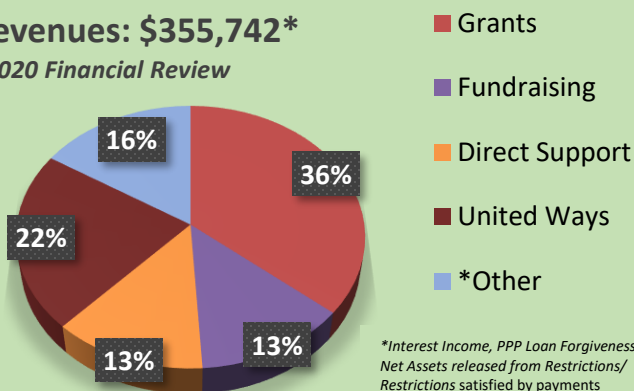
